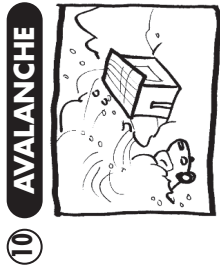
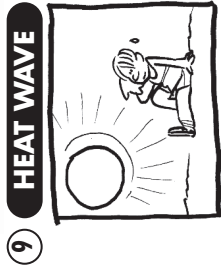
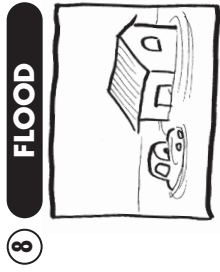
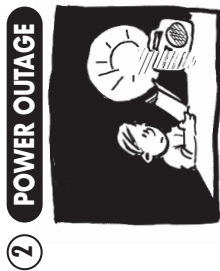
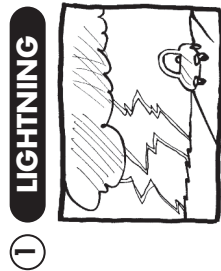


Can you match the emergency situation to its description?
