You always walk home from school with a friend, but today you decide to walk home alone and take the shortcut through the empty field...</p>		<p>a - Help the adult find the puppy even though he/she is a stranger.</p> <p>b - Go to the nearest sales clerk and ask for help.</p> <p>c - Avoid dangerous situations like walking home alone and taking shortcuts.</p> <p>d - Go and play in the toy department.</p> <p>e - You say "sure" and get in the car.</p> <p>f - Say "NO" to helping the stranger find his/her lost puppy. It's all right to say NO to adults if they want you to do something you know is wrong.</p> <p>g - You say "NO" and keep walking, never accept a car ride from anyone unless you have your parent's permission.</p> <p>h - It's all right to take the shortcut because you will get home faster.</p>
