Answers:
 1. B. Sometimes the traffic light is red, but the pedestrian light shows you may cross — but look out for traffic and be sure you are seen.
 2. B. Don't start to cross when the pedestrian light is flashing. If you are already crossing, continue to the other side.
 3. C. Retro-reflective materials reflect light back from vehicle headlights. Next best is white or light-coloured clothing.
 4. A. Traffic lights and crosswalks set rules for the flow of traffic, and make it safer for pedestrians to cross.
