

How to play Lines and Dots:

Players take turns joining two horizontally or vertically adjacent dots by a line. A player that completes the fourth side of a square (a box) writes their intials inside that box and must play again. When all boxes have been initialed, the game ends and the player who has initialed more boxes wins.



How to play Tic-Tac-Toe

The object of Tic-Tac-Toe is to get three in a row. The first player is known as X and the second is O. Players alternate placing Xs and Os on the game board until either player has three in a row or all nine squares are filled. X always goes first, and in the event that no one has three in a row, it is a tie and the game restarts.
